Become a Language Bank Volunteer

Language constitutes a significant barrier for monolingual or limited-English survivors of domestic & sexual violence as they look for services and start their healing journey.

Help CPAF break down that barrier for immigrant API clients!

CPAF invites you to apply to be a Language Bank volunteer!

Volunteers work closely with Community Programs staff and Family Advocates to provide interpretation for clients during individual and group counseling, women's program sessions, meetings and shelter orientations, and community workshops/presentations. Volunteers also provide written translation of application forms, notices, official communications, outreach materials, and web content as needed.

Requirements: LiveScan Background check; TB test; volunteer application and interview; fluency in English and an API language; completion of CPAF's one-day Language Bank Training
