If you're interested in helping survivors move from shelter to transitional or permanent housing, **CPAF invites you apply to be a Volunteer Housing Specialist.** Volunteers work closely with Family Advocates to identify and research housing resources and prepare clients for the application process.

Requirements: LiveScan Background check; TB test; volunteer application and interview; completion of CPAF's 65-hour Advocate Training
